About the journal

PSYBER NEWS is a half-yearly, peer-reviewed international psychology publication under the patronage of Prasad Psycho Pvt. Ltd., India, offering a platform for researchers, educators, clinicians, and students to publish high-quality, need-oriented scholarly work.

Scope and sections

We publish original, evidence-based manuscripts across psychology and allied fields, including assessment, psychometrics, mental health, education, counseling, organizational behavior, neuroscience, psych informatics, and interdisciplinary research.

Sections:

- (1) Research Articles — empirical, experimental, qualitative, mixed-methods, reviews, meta-analyses, scale development/validation, psychometric studies, tutorials;
- (2) Current News—conference/workshop reports, interviews, test/tool announcements, academic innovations, awards

Manuscript types & word limits

- Research Articles: ~4,000–6,000 words.
- Current News/Short Items: brief reports (typically ≤ 300 –1,000 words depending on item).

General requirements

- Original, unpublished work not under consideration elsewhere.
- Ethical compliance: IEC/IRB approval and informed consent where applicable; include an Ethics Statement for human participant research.
- Disclose conflicts of interest and funding sources.
- AI use for writing/editing must be declared; AI cannot be an author.
- Similarity index should generally not exceed 15% (excluding references/method sections); plagiarism reports (Turnitin/Urkund) may be requested.

Formatting & style (APA 7)

- Prepare in Microsoft Word; follow APA 7th edition for citations and references.
- Font: Times New Roman (12 pt), double-spaced, 1-inch margins, left-aligned, consecutive page numbers.
- Use APA heading levels, include DOIs where available, and use bias-free language.
- Tables are editable (not images); figures are ≥ 300 dpi and cited in text.

Submission process (two stages)

1. Abstract submission: separate, anonymous abstract (≤ 200 words) for double-blind review; include 3–6 keywords. Provide a separate title page with author names, affiliations, ORCID (recommended), contact details, and corresponding author.
2. Full paper submission: submit the full manuscript (Word) following APA 7 and the journal's structure (Title, Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Literature Review, Methodology, Results & Discussion, Conclusion, Recommendations & Implications, Future Research & Limitations, References). Research with human participants must include an ethics statement and informed consent details. In exceptional cases, simultaneous abstract and full paper submission may be allowed.

Peer review & decisions

All submissions undergo editorial screening and double-blind peer review by subject experts; decisions are based on originality, methodological rigor, ethical compliance, clarity, and contribution to the field. The Editorial Board may accept, reject, or request revisions.

Copyright & ethics

Authors must secure permissions for copyrighted material, ensure co-author approval, and comply with publication ethics; accepted manuscripts may require a signed publication agreement. Authors remain responsible for accuracy and originality.
